State election – version five – March 3, 2022

These are the issues we, the voters, want the next Member for Hammond to address after he or she is elected to state parliament in 2022:

1. **Infrastructure:** We want public transport services, roads and planning laws to keep pace with Murray Bridge's continued population growth.
2. **COVID-19:** We want South Australia to chart a course out of the pandemic, and for our leaders to address people's concerns about vaccines and activity restrictions.
